

## **GEO 3900 UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH**

**SPRING – SUMMER – WINTER SEMESTERS**

*Student research under the guidance of specific faculty advisor.*

Credit: 1 or 2 semesters; 1 – 3 credit hours

Meeting: The student and faculty advisor may arrange the research effort in any way that suits them best. If suitable, students are encouraged to present a poster at the Department's annual Research Symposium at the end of April, Spring Semester.

Before you register for GEO 3900:

- a) Identify the **Faculty Advisor** who will supervise the research
- b) In consultation with Faculty Advisor prepare a project description
- c) Obtain Faculty Advisor's permission before enrolling in GEO 3900
- d) Register for GEO 3900 and go to the CANVAS link for GEO 3900

After you register for GEO 3900 - by the end of the *first week of the semester*:

- a) Submit your project description through CANVAS (pdf).
- b) **Ask** your Faculty Advisor to send an email to the 'Instructor of Record' indicating that s/he will be supervising your project.

At the end of the semester (by the last day of exams are or earlier): We must hear about how your research turned out!

- a) Student submits a brief report summarizing the findings of the research through CANVAS GEO 3900 (pdf document). The report may consist of a narrative, abstract, or poster.
- b) **Ask** Faculty Advisor to report a grade for the research effort by email to the *Instructor of Record for GEO 3900* ([erich.petersen@utah.edu](mailto:erich.petersen@utah.edu)) *who will submit the grade for credit. **Grade will be submitted only after student 'report' AND faculty advisor's email are received.***
